

### **Documents Checklist-1 for admission in B.Sc-N Courses:-**

- Matriculation Certificate (10<sup>th</sup>) Copy ( Age Criteria **17 years** minimum entry age as on 31<sup>st</sup> Dec of the session and no maximum age limit )
- Higher Secondary Certificate (**10+2- Medical Only**) or its equivalent examination copy with details of marks in each subject. (**45% marks** in Biology,Physics & Chemistry taken together & 40% marks for SC/ST/OBC while English is compulsory subject in 10+2
- H.P. Bonafide/Domicile Certificate copy from the Tehsildar/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate of the Area concerned or valid resident proof for other state
- Character Certificate from the Principal of the School /Institutions last attended.
- Latest Character Certificate from the Tehsildar/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate of the Area concerned.
- Category//Sub Category Certificates of claiming reservation under particular reserved category including sub-reserved category issued by the competent authority. (SC/ST/OBC/BPL/IRDP/Handicapped)
- Adhar Card/VID
- 5- passport type coloured photographs
- Migration Certificate from the concerned 10+2/ Higher Education Board/University- ORIGINAL required if other than HP Board
- Anti ragging Declaration on the plain paper
- Affidavit -in case of married candidates / in case of Gap after 10+2
- AMRU Admission Form
- AMRU Allotment Letter

### **Documents Checklist-2 after confirmed admission in B.Sc-N Courses:-**

- Medical Fitness Certificate from the govt. authorized person of the area concern – Govt. Hospital only (as per prescribed format from the college)
- Declaration on the stamp paper of Rs. 20/- duly notarised ( as per prescribed format from college)
- Hostel Application Form (as per prescribed by college)
